PARADE TIMES

Thursday, May 21st

- Kelly Sicks's Class: Start lining up at 8:30 am. Parade begins a 9:00 am
- Natalie Britt's Class: Start lining up at 9:30 am. Parade begins a 10:00 am
- Ashley Davis's Class: Start lining up at 10:30 am. Parade begins a 11:00 am
- Lacey Jeffrey's Class: Start lining up at 1:30 pm. Parade begins a 2:00 pm
- Amy Smith's Class: Start lining up at 2:30 pm. Parade begins a 3:00 pm

Friday, May 22nd

- Amanda Thurman's Class: Start lining up at 8:30 am. Parade begins a 9:00 am
- Brandi Stewart's Class: Start lining up at 9:30 am. Parade begins a 10:00 am
- Jennifer Foster's Class: Start lining up at 10:30 am. Parade begins a 11:00 am
- Madison Foster's Class: Start lining up at 1:30 pm. Parade begins a 2:00 pm
- Leslie Gearing's Class: Start lining up at 2:30 pm. Parade begins a 3:00 pm

PARADE ROUTE

- Line up in the front parking lot
- Start by traveling south on Vivian Merritt St.
- Turn right onto Smurr Ave.
- Turn right onto Ingram St.
- Go north on Ingram St.
- Arrive at the rear entrance to the campus by the softball field
- Turn right onto campus.

The parade of cars will travel through the parking lot toward the 1st/2nd grade car pickup area. There, each car will briefly park to allow the child to be greeted by school administration and his/her teacher and receive their certificate. Afterward cars will exit toward Vivian Merritt.

Spectators are encouraged to stand along Ingram St. to cheer for our little panthers.
